A Key Worker is required to join the residential education staff group. This is an important role in the residential provision, supporting the waking day educational environment for students. This includes extending their curriculum skills, social skills, life and independent skills and personal development. You will be a personal tutor to students, contributing to annual reviews and end of year reports. You will be involved in rota duties such as sleeping in.

Applicants will be expected to hold a relevant qualification at NVQ level 3 or be prepared to work towards acquiring one. The hours for this permanent post are 16hrs per week in early mornings, afternoons, and evening shifts during Monday to Friday.
